coproduces the sitcom with creator Ed. Weinberger (*Taxi*, *Amen*). "If you put a serious spin on this kind of material, nobody listens. But some of the hypocrisy people show in the name of religion is what gives us our comedy."

WE SAY: There are so many conflicting elements—gospel music, sexual energy, Bible readings, physical shtick, social messages, street jive—that it shouldn't work. But somehow it all comes together in an appealing, if somewhat awkward, package. And hey, with Billy Preston playing the organ and a choir full of great '70s funk singers, how can we complain?
